Nine other qualifications were also awarded 1 Star Rating namely: Bartending NC II, Beauty Care NC II, Cookery NC II, Driving NC II, Food Processing NC II, Front Office Services NC II, Housekeeping NC II, Massage Therapy NC II and DomRAC NC II.

The award was given during the 2nd National Quality TVET Forum on October 27, 2017 at the Crowne Plaza Manila Galleria Hotel, Ortigas Avenue, Quezon City. Twelve LSF Trainers together with Ms. Ruth R. Pundang – Vo-

cational School Administrator III attended the awarding ceremony along with the other 675 Star Rating Awardees from different Technical Vocational Institutions all over the country.

The Star Rating System is a means of recognizing Technical Vocational Education and Training (TVET) programs beyond the minimum registration requirements in furtherance of quality assured TVET systems that is composed of 4 criteria namely: Program Governance and Management, Curriculum Program and Delivery, Support Services and Program Performance Measures.
